Any person who is at least 18 years old and either lives or owns a business in West St. Paul or Mendota Heights. All eligible applicants will be screened by conducting a criminal history check (a prior criminal conviction will not automatically disqualify an applicant).

Is There A Fee?

No. The academy is free to persons who either live or own a business in West St. Paul or Mendota Heights.

How Is The Class Conducted?

How Can Information From This Academy Be Used By The Police and Citizens?

Students meet one night each week from 6:30pm to 9:30pm for 7 weeks. They receive a total of 21 hours of instruction from police officers and other criminal justice professionals.

The Citizen Police Academy is a 21 hour, 7 week course designed to give West St. Paul and Mendota Heights citizens a working knowledge of the operations and responsibilities of the West St. Paul and Mendota Heights Police. The slogan of the Citizen Academy is; “Understanding Through Education”, with the ultimate goal of providing citizen participants with the in-depth information and insight needed to build trust and increase positive interaction between the police and the community.
