



2008 Coon Rapids Police Citizens Academy

DESCRIPTION

Participants will learn a variety of topics and participate in lectures, demonstrations, tours, ride-along, and hands-on exercises. Each session will commit to meeting 3 hours, one night a week for 11 weeks (33 hours total). At graduation, each participant will receive a certificate of completion from the City of Coon Rapids.

DATES

Wednesday evenings, starting in September and continuing through November. Each date will have a different curriculum with varying topics, presenters, and outside speakers. The sessions run from 6:00 or 6:30 pm to 9:30 or 10:00 pm each Wednesday.

For 2008 the start date is September 10, 2008

COST

FREE. A polo "uniform" shirt provided. Participants are asked to wear their polo shirt and khaki (or similar) trousers to each session.

ELIGIBILITY

Resident of, or business owner/significant employment connection with, Coon Rapids (no law enforcement students please);
At least 21 years of age;
Successfully pass a criminal background check

GOALS

Enhance public safety
Help citizens understand law enforcement strategies and problems
Reduce crime and present crime prevention materials
Build relationships with the community
Create police ambassadors to the community
